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In the News

- Benzhydrocodone is now available for acute pain. It is chemically inert until ingested, then metabolizes to hydrocodone.
- <u>J & J opioid settlement reduced by \$106 million</u> with \$50 Billion more pending for manufacturers to settle multiple opioid crisis suits.
- Academy of Emergency Medicine released it's White Paper on Management of Opioid Use Disorder in the Emergency Department.
- Hundreds of thousands of <u>fentanyl-laced counterfeit pills</u> flood the streets; contributing to fentanyl being a leading OD death cause.
- Virtual Reality use during childbirth may help some women in labor; with or without traditional analgesics.
- FDA approved a new high frequency spinal cord stimulator with the versatility likely to overcome interpatient variability in responses.
- Massachusetts & other states that criminalize substance use during pregnancy have higher rates of neonatal abstinence syndrome.
- Used to reduce pain and inflammation of osteoarthritis, corticosteroid injections may hasten joint degeneration & need for surgery.

- James JR, Scott JM, Klein JW, et al. <u>Mortality after discontinuation of primary care—based chronic opioid therapy for pain</u>: a retrospective cohort study. *J Gen Intern Med*. 2019 Dec;34(12):2749-55. More pain patients who stop opioids die within 5-years.
- Atiquzzaman M, Karim ME, Kopec J, et al. Role of nonsteroidal antiinflammatory drugs (NSAIDs) in the association between
 osteoarthritis and cardiovascular diseases: a longitudinal study. *Arthritis Rheumatol*. 2019 Nov;71(11):1835 1843. <u>NSAIDs for
 arthritis contribute to cardiovascular disease</u>. Pain patients taking NSAIDS are 23% more likely to develop cardiovascular disease.
- Zebala JA, Searle SL, Webster LR, et al. Desmetramadol has the safety and analgesic profile of tramadol without its metabolic liabilities: consecutive randomized, double-blind, placebo- and active comparator-controlled trials. *J Pain*. 2019 Oct;20(10):1218-1235. Tramadol analogue has similar safety & efficacy as tramadol with less concern about metabolic & drug interactions.
- Deer TR, Malinowski M, Varshney V, et al. Choice of intrathecal drug in the treatment of neuropathic pain new research. Expert Rev Clin Pharmacol. 2019;12(10):1003-7. For neuropathic pain refractory to treatment, IT drug delivery may provide prolonged relief.
- Fortenberry M, Crowder J, So TY. The use of <u>codeine and tramadol in the pediatric</u> population-what is the verdict now? *J Pediatr Health Care*. 2019;33(1):117-123. Codeine & tramadol are still given despite recommendations to avoid them under 12 years old.
- Franzini A, Moosa S, D'Ammando A, et al. The <u>neurosurgical treatment of craniofacial pain syndromes</u>: current surgical indications and techniques. *Neurol Sci.* 2019;40(Sup 1):159-168. Craniofacial pain refractory to medical management may benefit from surgery.
- Charles A, Pozo-Rosich P. Targeting calcitonin gene-related peptide: a <u>new era in migraine therapy</u>. *Lancet*. 2019 Nov 394(10210): 1765-74. Migraine, the 4th most prevalent & disabling disorders worldwide, may be reduced with new CGRP treatment options.

- Darnall BD, Ziadni MS, Krishnamurthy P, et al. "My Surgical Success": A digital behavioral pain medicine method cuts time to opioid cessation after breast cancer surgery—a pilot randomized controlled clinical trial. Pain Med. 2019 Nov; 20(11): 2228–37. Although just over half with access used it, digital behavioral health was an acceptable, feasible way to help postop patients cut opioid exposure.
- Watson JA, Ryan CG, Cooper L, et al. <u>Pain neuroscience education for adults with chronic musculoskeletal pain</u>: a mixed-methods systematic review and meta-analysis. *J Pain*. 2019 Oct;20(10):1140.e1-1140.e22. Helping chronic musculoskeletal pain patients view it differently helps them cope; cuts pain, disability, and improves psychosocial outcomes. The educator's knowledge & skills is a factor.
- Machado FC, Vieira J, et al. <u>Intraoperative methadone reduces pain and opioid consumption</u> in acute postoperative pain: A systematic review and meta-analysis. *Anesth Analg.* 2019; Dec.129:1723-1732. Intraoperative methadone cuts pain for 2 days after surgery.
- Herr K, Coyne PJ, Ely E, et al. Pain assessment in the patient unable to self-report: clinical practice recommendations in support of its position statement. *Pain Manag Nurs.* 2019 Oct. 20(5): 404-417. <u>Updated evidence-based way to assess pain in nonverbal patients</u>.
- French SD, Nielsen M, Hall L, et al. Essential key messages about diagnosis, imaging, and self-care for people with low back pain: a
 modified Delphi study of consumer and expert opinions. *Pain*. 2019 Dec;160(12):2787-2797. Patients with back pain should remain
 active & understand pain doesn't represent harm after serious pathology is ruled out. Then focus on learning pain management skills.

Complementary Integrative Health

- Optimism increases goal-directed activity, reduces pain related disability & creates a virtuous cycle that enhances well-being
- Emerging research supports the notion that <u>gut microbiome plays a key role in pain</u> of gut, inflammatory & neuropathic origin.
- Combining manual therapy with exercise for chronic neck pain is better than standard P.T. for reducing pain & disability.
- <u>Injected neuromodulation device</u> could someday replace or augment transcutaneous or other electrical nerve stimulators.
- Holding the hand of a loved one can ease pain, emotional comfort & social connectedness for women, with brain changes observed.
- Many people with chronic pain benefit from couples interventions (education, counselling, supporting, and reinforcing).
