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In the News

- Congresswoman develops a perforated ulcer from ibuprofen taken for more than the recommended 2-week limit for lingering surgical pain
- Opioid overdose deaths last year rose only 5% in Massachusetts, less than other states, but the <u>overdose rates soared 69% for Blacks</u>.
- Currently being developed for cancer, HDAC6 inhibitors, may restore neuronal flexibility to improve pain therapy responsiveness.
- FDA declined to approve IV tramadol, given delayed & unpredictable relief by itself & lack of safety data if combined with other analgesics.
- New implantable neurostimulator for pain has an 11-year battery life and adapts to the patient's movement or body position.
- Virtual meeting July 16th 10am 5pm to discuss revising CDC Guidelines for Prescribing Opioids with public comment @ 2:15 4:15pm.

- Wan EYF, Yu YET, Chan L, et al. Comparative risks of nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs on CKD. Clin J Am Soc Nephrol. 2021, Jun;16(6):898-907. People who take <u>NSAIDs over 28 days per year have a significantly risk of reduced kidney function measure (eGFR)</u> within 9 years; more than double that of people with no NSAID use. Ibuprofen may be least toxic, & etoricoxib most toxic to the kidneys.
- Morin M, et al. Multimodal physical therapy versus topical lidocaine for provoked vestibulodynia: a multicenter, randomized trial. Am J
 Obstet Gynecol. 2021 Feb;224(2):189.e1-189.e12. Physical Therapy improved pain, sexual function & distress more than topical lidocaine.
- Nicola M, Correia H, et al. Invalidation of chronic pain: a thematic analysis of pain narratives. Disabil Rehabil. 2021;43(6):861–869. Pain-invalidation is a stigmatizing barrier to seeking treatment & adhering to a treatment plan. Believing patients in a non-judgmental way helps.
- Lewis GN, Bean DJ. What influences outcomes from inpatient multidisciplinary pain management programs? a systematic review & Meta-analysis Clin J Pain. 2021 Jul;37(7):504-23. Inpatient multidisciplinary pain programs have long term pain, emotion & functional benefits.
- Willingham MD, Vila MR, Ben A, et al. Factors contributing to lingering pain after surgery: The role of patient expectations. Anesthesiology.
 Jun 1;134(6):915-924. Surgical factors, pain intensity & expectations of chronic pain contributed to pain 3 months after surgery
- Sort R, Brorson S, Gögenur I,et al. Peripheral nerve block anaesthesia and postoperative pain in acute ankle fracture surgery. Br J Anaesth. 2021 Apr;126(4):881-8. Pain & opioid use were lower with peripheral nerve blocks than spinal anesthesia, until they wore off.
- Gulia A, Dhamija E, et al. Impact of early intervention in pain management in cancer patients- a randomised controlled study in a tertiary care cancer hospital. *Clin J Pain*. 2021 Apr 1;37(4):259-64. Nerve blocks plus opioids get better cancer pain outcomes than opioids alone.
- Burns S, Urman R, Pian R, et al. Reducing new persistent opioid use after surgery: a review of interventions. *Curr Pain Headache Rep.* 2021 Mar 24;25(5):27. Prudent prescribing, monitoring use & opioid-sparing multimodal analgesia cuts opioid use after surgery.
- Wan BA, Pidduck W, Zhang L, et al. Patient-reported pain in <u>patients with breast cancer who receive radiotherapy</u>. Pain Manag Nurs. 2021
 Jun;22(3):402-7. Breast cancer patients had less post-radiotherapy pain if they had adjuvant chemotherapy &/or chest wall radiation;
 whereas those with higher baseline pain &/or locoregional RT had higher post-radiation pain that should be monitored and treated..

- Racaru S, Sturt J, Celik A. The <u>effects of psychological interventions on diabetic peripheral neuropathy</u>: a systematic review and metaanalysis. *Pain Manag Nurs*. 2021 Jun;22(3):302-311. Relaxation/breathing techniques, CBT, Mindfulness & counseling interventions reduce pain, improve functioning, mood & self-care for patients with painful diabetic neuropathy. Strongest effects were for acute pain reduction.
- Dear BF, Karin E, Fogliati R, et al. A cost-effectiveness analysis of an internet-delivered pain management program delivered with different levels of clinician support: a randomised controlled trial. J Pain. 2021 Mar;22(3):344-358. An internet-delivered pain management program showed cost-effective clinical benefits (e.g. ≥ 30% lower disability, depression, anxiety & pain) even with different levels of clinician support.
- Zhen N, De-Sheng C, et al. The <u>analgesic effect of ketorolac addition for renal colic</u> pain: A meta-analysis of randomized controlled studies. Am J Emerg Med. 2021 May;43:12-16. Adding ketorolac to analgesics for renal colic pain enhances efficacy without more GI side effects.
- Lee HM, Park JH, Park SJ, et al. Comparison of monotherapy versus combination of intravenous ibuprofen and acetaminophen for reduction
 of postoperative opioid administration in children undergoing laparoscopic hernia repair: a double-blind randomized controlled trial. Anesth
 Analg 2021 Jul 1;133(1):168-75. Intravenous ibuprofen + acetaminophen reduce pain & opioid used after pediatric laparoscopic hernia repair.
- Fritz JM, Davis AF, Burgess DJ, et al. Pivoting to <u>virtual delivery for managing chronic pain with nonpharmacological treatments</u>: implications for pragmatic research. *Pain*. 2021 Jun 1;162(6):1591-96. Non-drug treatments can be effectively delivered virtually on a large scale.
- Erzincanli S, Kasar KS. Effect of hand massage on pain, anxiety, and vital signs in patients before venipuncture procedure: a RCT. Pain
 Manag Nurs. 2021 Jun;22(3):356-360. A 5-6-minute bilateral arm & hand massage cut anxiety, BP & pulse but not pain during venipuncture.

- Specialized spa therapy (18 sessions) helped people with Fibromyalgia that lasted 6-12 months after treatments were completed.
- Online <u>Acceptance & Commitment Therapy effectively improves chronic pain and desired outcomes</u> like improved functioning & mood.
- Stellate ganglion low-level laser therapy may restore autonomic nervous system balance to help with fibromyalgia and related conditions.
- Sound nutritional principles & foods to avoid for people with intractable pain delineated in this new guide.
- Acupuncture reduces pain in children and adolescents with sickle cell disease during painful sickle cell crises.
- Virtual Reality reduces pain more than other distraction methods for children in the Emergency Department to reduce venipuncture pain.
